Teachers reported LitCamp **developed students' social-emotional skills** around what the program refers to as the **7 STRENGTHS**

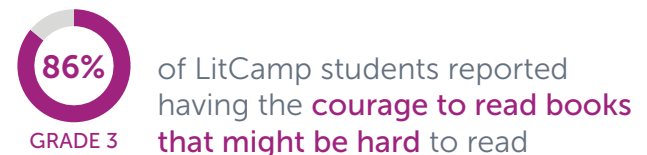


Teachers rated LitCamp as **effective at developing students' abilities** to
