<p><b>My Books Every Day</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Diverse and engaging <b>take-home books</b> for PreK–3 students (3 themed packs, 5 books per pack)</li> <li>- <b>Student Journal</b> to help students relate to books and build vocab, text-to-self connections, critical thinking, and literacy skills</li> <li>- <b>Family Guide</b> to strengthen language and literacy development in the home</li> <li>- <b>Program Guide</b> to provide classroom discussion prompts that connect to the take-home books</li> <li>- <b>Online resources</b> to support family and educator implementation, including shareable messages that promote at-home reading</li> </ul> <p><b>Educators/Schools</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Distribution logistics</b> and timeline for sending books home</li> <li>- <b>Regular communication</b> with families and students about literacy strategies and take-home book content</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Build home libraries with the take-home books</li> <li>- Interact with the books at home</li> <li>- Engage with self-development activities in the Student Journal</li> </ul> <p><b>Educators</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Leverage sending the take-home book home as an opportunity to connect directly with families and caregivers</li> <li>- Spark classroom discussions about take-home books using online prompts</li> <li>- Support family efforts to engage with text and promote literacy with the online family literacy tips</li> </ul> <p><b>Families</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Strengthen literacy practices through access and use of the take-home books</li> <li>- Deepen literacy development using the Family Guide tips and online resources</li> <li>- Use online discussion prompts to build connections between the text and their family identity</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Increase access to literature designed to inspire the joy of reading</li> <li>- Strengthen interest in reading via positive literacy experiences at home and school</li> <li>- Develop resilience and a growth mindset to support academic achievement</li> </ul> <p><b>Educators</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Increase frequency of positive school-to-home communications</li> <li>- Create a strong reading culture spanning from classroom to home</li> </ul> <p><b>Families</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Establish and/or strengthen positive home-to-school connections</li> <li>- Create/expand a text-rich environment at home</li> <li>- Incorporate reading and book discussions into the family routine</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Receive access to books at home that depict a variety of characters and experiences</li> <li>- Spend more time reading at home for pleasure</li> </ul> <p><b>Educators</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Establish a literacy community that bridges from the classroom to the home</li> <li>- Increase positive and two-way communication between school and home</li> </ul> <p><b>Families</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Increase at-home discussions related to books</li> <li>- Improve relationship with educator(s)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Increase personal motivation to read</li> <li>- Improve confidence in personal identity and as an independent thinker</li> </ul> <p><b>Educators</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- See a rise in positive classroom behaviors and higher student engagement</li> </ul> <p><b>Families</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Develop a positive perception of literacy and stronger family bond through reading</li> </ul>
